VIENNA

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MADONNA

Pop icon Madonna wore and signed this fedora during her 'Who's That Girl' tour in the late 1980s.

THE BEATLES

The Beatles' 1967 masterpiece, 'Sgt. Pepper's Lonely Hearts Club Band', is among the most creative and ambitious albums ever recorded. This is an original horn arrangement manuscript for the title track. It has been signed by all four members of the group.

MÖTLEY CRÜE

Nikki Sixx of Los Angeles-based heavy metal icons Mötley Crüe used this stunning Hamer Scarab bass on stage with the group. It has been heavily customized to Nikki's personal specifications.

ALICE COOPER

Guitarist Ryan Roxie used this lovely GMP guitar on stage with Alice Cooper during Alice's 1998 'Rock 'n' Roll Carnival' tour.

BON JOVI

Guitarist Richie Sambora used this stunning Dobro resonator guitar on the song "Two Story Town" from the 2000 album 'Crush'.

BRUCE SPRINGSTEEN

"The Boss" wore this shirt on stage during his 1992-1993 world tour. This was the first time Springsteen toured without the E Street Band.

THE ROLLING STONES

Mick Jagger wore this military-style coat on stage during the Rolling Stones 1989-1990 'Steel Wheels/Urban Jungle' tour.

KATY PERRY

Pop superstar Katy Perry wore this vintage-style dress during a backstage meet & greet prior to her February 27th, 2011 show here in Vienna.

COLDPLAY

Chris Martin of Coldplay owned this Yamaha CP-70 electric piano. It can be seen the band's video for "Shiver".

KISS

Gene Simmons of KISS played this elaborately painted Cort Axe Bass on stage at the Hard Rock Cafe in Nashville, Tennessee on September 4th, 2012.

AEROSMITH

This heavily customized, Lucite Dan Armstrong guitar was owned and played by Joe Perry of Aerosmith.

QUEEN

The late, great Freddie Mercury of Queen wore this absolutely amazing outfit on stage when Queen performed in Rio de Janeiro on January 18th, 1985.

VIENNA BOYS' CHOIR
